

- D. The MoU shall remain in force for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a three months notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
- E. The parties to this MoU undertake to treat as **CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED** information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of discloser shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
- F. This MoU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions.
 - 1. In order to carry out the above activities, a detailed plan may be agreed to upon consultation.
 - It is implicit that every activity undertaken under this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and must fall within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints.
 - 3. This agreement shall be effective on and after the date of its signing by the authorized representatives of the two institutions, and shall remain in force until either party wishes to terminate. In order to terminate, a three months written notice must be issued.


