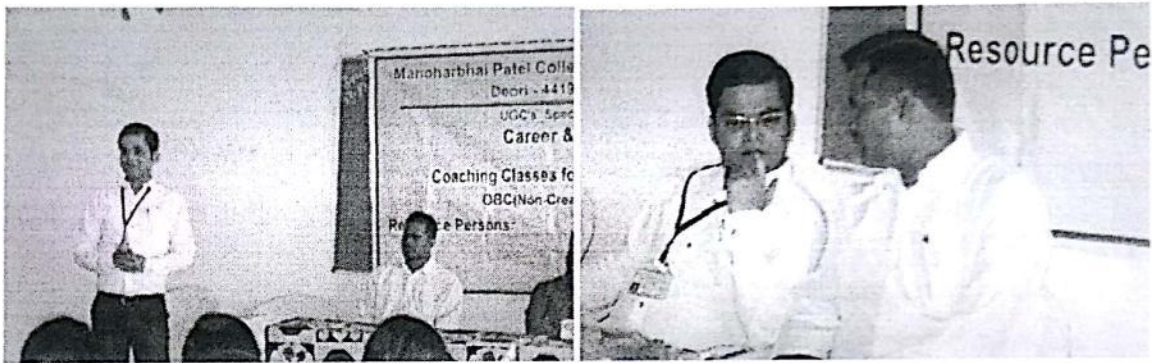
The chief guest of the function was Dr. C. K. Gajbhiye and the programme was presided over by Prof. S. S. Chourasia along with the faculty.


can be made after graduation. He emphasized on competing the various competitive exams like UPSC and MPSC and elaborated the various facets associated with it.

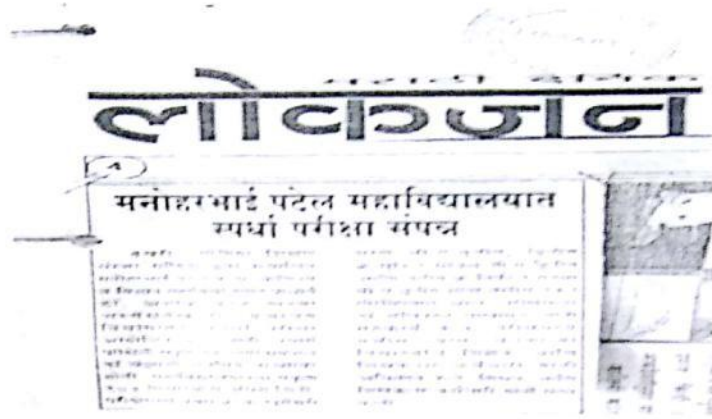




